It is with a heavy heart that we have come to the conclusion that we must close our Fair Street Recycling operations. As many of our loyal customers already know, we have been closed since early March because of the COVID-19 pandemic and the resulting Shelter-in-Place directives.

The primary reason that we are closing is because the main revenue source for the operation is the sale of crushed aluminum on the wholesale market. Unfortunately, the world price of wholesale aluminum has fallen to a level that no longer allows us to sustain our operation.

Fair Street Recycling has been a mainstay business of the Work Training Center for the past 30 years and we have arrived at this decision with a heavy heart as it will be a loss to our clients and to the community that has supported us.

With the sale of our property on Fair Street, we are looking to relocate our other commercial enterprises including our Landscaping and Nursery operations along with our Janitorial services. Through these businesses, we look forward to continuing to support our many customers throughout Butte County.
